

Dry Creek Mens Club Tournament Rules and Procedures

- Rules for the event are posted on the white board next to scorer's table and on back of scorecard.
- Players are responsible for knowing the rules of the competition.
- We play by the USGA Rules of Golf and Local Rules unless stated otherwise.
- Tournament Committee will post scores; please **do not** post your own score.
- Mark the **gross** hole by hole player score on score card and tally all scores, attest and sign scorecards before returning to scorers table. **We can't read scribbles and mark-outs/write-overs.**
- Play is from the Blue tee markers. Except for the Rules of Golf and Local Rules, and as stated on white board, play the course as you find it, the ball as it lies. Distance measuring devices only are allowed. When in doubt as to procedure, invoke Rule 3.3 by playing 2 balls and declaring which ball you want to score with, if allowable. Waste area between 14, 15 and 16 and the irrigation pond and waste area between 2, 9 & 18 are Lateral Hazards. Ball hitting wires on #8 or #12 is a mandatory re-hit. Member scores are always posted by Tournament Committee.
- Tournament winnings paid in Dry Creek Gift Certificates; these **are not** good for greens fees or cart fees on tournament days. Dry Creek management can order most golf items you need such as bags, clubs, shoes, rain suits, etc. Skins paid in cash but aren't calculated until all scoring is completed and results posted.
- Closest to pins on all par 3's.

Please observe pace of play courtesy by keeping up with the group in front of you. Return to clubhouse ASAP to turn in signed and attested scorecards, then put your clubs away
